

HIGH GLOSS FURNITURE CARE

On a daily basis you can wipe over the High Gloss furniture with a feather duster to remove any dust that might accumulate throughout the day. To remove finger marks or sticky patches, you should use the microfiber cloth with a touch of soapy water and 'buff' away the fingermarks and patches. Ensure that you don't apply too much pressure when cleaning the surfaces as they can easily be damaged.

If you spill any food or drink on your High Gloss Furniture, it is recommended that you wipe it away immediately. This is because the Lacquer Paint could become stained by the spilled substance. But if this isn't possible, use a microfiber cloth with some soapy water and it should easily wipe right off. After you have cleaned your High Gloss Furniture you can use a dry microfiber cloth to buff away the water to create a beautiful shine.

Overall:

1. Use a feather duster to remove day to day dust
2. Microfibre cloth with water removes finger prints or sticky patches
3. Wipe up food or drink spillages immediately
4. Dry microfibre cloth to buff away excess water

DO NOT:

1. **Do not** use chemical cleaners
2. **Do not** leave food or drink spillages.
3. **Do not** apply pressure whilst cleaning and wiping.
